Thank you all for another successful Read-A-Thon. There were about 30 schools and daycare centers that participated with documented reading of over 5,000 hours and raised over \$37,000.00. Most of the funds went to student prizes of paperback books, bags, hardcover books, and gift cards, and top student prizes. Top Student Prizes included a Kindle for Kids, a cell phone with \$10 loads each month for one year, and Apple AirPods. In

addition, top students also received a paperback book, RAT 2024 book bag, hardcover book, and \$50 gift card. 


